

## You Can Now Receive Credit for Your Participation In Robotics!

Here is how it works:

If you are a Sophomore, Junior or Senior at M-A:

- **Sign-up: Secure an Independent Study Form and Get It Signed**

- In December: pick up an Independent Study Form in the Guidance Office

- In December: Secure Mr. DeCurtins' signature on the Independent Study Form

- **Level of Participation**

- Depending on your level of participation, credits will be assessed from 1 - 5 credits during the Spring Semester

- Participation is primarily determined during the build season (January 3 - February 17) Note: the Build Sessions, which vary in length, are usually held on Wednesday night, Friday night, and Saturday and Sunday. The famous "Robotics Crunch" is Friday, February 13 - Monday, Feb 16). There are also post-build meetings and competitions.

- **Type of credit awarded**

- The Independent Study is recorded as "I.S. Robotics" for the Spring Semester (i.e. a semester course)

- The elective is a "regular elective", providing students with units toward their 60 required units of electives. (i.e. it is not a Science elective, Practical Arts or Technology elective)

- A student can get Independent Study for Robotics for a total of 10 units (i.e. twice)
